Once at the site you will have time to explore this ancient town on your own an opportunity that will provide insight into the history of this amazing and very large archaeological site. On the journey back to the port a short stop is also scheduled at a local coral factory. Please note: as the tour involves longer periods of walking on uneven ground (i.e. boulders in the streets of Pompeii) it is not recommended for guests using a wheelchair. Some ramps have been installed throughout the rolling path in Pompeii to provide a wheelchair friendly path though with some limitations to some areas inside the site. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. The entrance tickets are not included in the price. Children under 18 years old must bring with them their valid ID card.


This flavourful look at the city of Naples will first take you to the time-honoured Caff? Gambrinus to have a cup of Neapolitan coffee. Then, walk until the amazing Toledo station to enjoy a short ride until Dante station and continue your pleasant walking tour. You'll cross Spaccanapoli en route to Piazza San Domenico and along Via San Gregorio Armeno, home to countless artisans crafting nativity scenes. At Via dei Tribunali you'll taste a pizza, served neatly folded up and eaten standing up in classic Neapolitan style. Next up is a taste of sfogliatella, a Neapolitan pastry, at the Scaturchio pastry shop on Piazza San Domenico Maggiore. Savour outside views of the Church of Santa Maria Maggiore della Pietrasanta as well as the late 15th-century Pontano Chapel, commissioned by the humanist Giovanni Pontano as a funerary chapel for his first wife. Piazza del Ges? Nuovo comes next, to see the Spire of the Immaculate Virgin and visit the Baroque Church of Ges? Nuovo, both built in the mid-18th century. A visit to the 14th-century Basilica of Santa Chiara, famed for its early Gothic style, and a walk back to the port concludes your Naepolitan experience.Please note: this tour includes long periods of walking and standing and is not suitable for guests using a wheelchair. 
When in Malta you can do no better than to pay a visit not only the island's current capital of Valletta but also the former capital of Mdina both of which are the fascinating destinations on this half-day tour. Valletta is first up where you will go to see the wonderful Barrakka Gardens a beautifully landscaped public park to savour breathtaking views of the Grand Harbour after which you will head for St. John's Co-Cathedral built by the Knights of Malta in the second half of the 16th-century. The ornately decorated interior is rich in treasures including a masterpiece by Caravaggio. The tour then continues to the medieval walled city of Mdina which is situated in the middle of the island and is also called "The Silent City" due to restrictions imposed on motorised traffic. You will get to visit the Baroque-style St. Paul's Cathedral which presides impressively over the town before enjoying a walk through the narrow streets and lanes of this piece of living history. Your tour then draws to a leisurely close with your return to the ship. Please note: as your visit to Mdina and Valletta will be entirely on foot and involves long periods of walking guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Even though all sites visited are wheelchair-friendly Valletta is mostly cobblestoned and might be uncomfortable for guests using a wheelchair. If they want to take part they must be accompanied by a paying helper to aid with getting on and off the coach; wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Wheelchair users wishing to take part in this are requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk promptly once they are on board so that arrangements can be made. If the tour falls on a Saturday afternoon and on Public/National Holiday the visit to the St. John's Co-Cathedral will be external only and guests will visit the National Museum instead. St. John's Co-Cathedral may close without prior notice for religious service. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for visits to sites of religious importance. 



Nearly opposite Cottonera lies the Maltese capital Valletta with its remarkably imposing bastions. The city has retained much of its architectural heritage and one of its most iconic sights is Valletta waterfront a marvel of 18th-century Baroque architecture that has been extensively restored. Do take your camera to capture awe-inspiring views of the waterfront while also enjoying a wine-tasting session at this unique location. Before returning to the ship you will stop briefly at the Mdina glass outlet at the Valletta waterfront. Please note: the tour is subject to wind/sea conditions on the day of the call. As there is only a narrow gangway to access the boat the tour is unsuitable for guests using a wheelchair.



Combine a pleasant walk in the fresh air with an exploration of some of Barcelona's most notable sights on an outing that begin with a short coach ride from the port. You'll then set off on a guided stroll, with the first landmark being the Columbus Monument at the lower end of La Rambla avenue. The 60 m/197 ft. monument was constructed in 1888 in honour of Columbus' first voyage to the New World. You'll then continue down La Rambla en route to Barcelona's Barri G?tic and the Neoclassical town hall at Pla?a Sant Jaume. Next up are outside views of the Gothic Cathedral of Santa Eul?lia - Barcelona Cathedral - and information on this key site. Last on your walking itinerary is Pla?a de Catalunya in the middle of town, just the place to indulge in a little retail therapy. At this point, you can choose whether to remain in the city and make your own way back to the ship or to join your guide on the walk back down La Rambla to board the coach for the transfer back to the port. Please note: this tour is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or using a wheelchair as it includes long periods of walking.

Our starting point for this day-long tour begins in Marseilles at the Basilica of Notre Dame de la Garde. This Neo-Byzantine church stands on top of a hill and was designed by the French architect Esperandiu between 1853 and 1864. The site was formerly a XIII century chapel dedicated to Our Lady of the Guard and features several votive offerings from safely returned sailors. Stop for an inside visit before continuing on a 1.5-hour coach ride to the medieval city of Avignon. Here we will visit the Palace of the Popes an ancient fortress rich in galleries and chapels. The frescoes and hand-painted tapestries in the Popes' bedrooms and private rooms bear witness to the former opulence of this residence. Make the most of your free time to stroll around and have lunch (noninclusive) in one of the typical French brasserie-restaurants. Return to Marseilles for embarkation. Please note: this tour includes walking on uneven ground in Avignon and walking uphill with some steps around the Basilica in Marseille; it is not available to guests who use a wheelchair. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. 

CULTURE AND HISTORY

While the sun-kissed shores of southern France make ideal holiday destinations the delightful towns lying inland are equally worth a visit. Designed to let you savour two such jewels the outing begins with a 40-minute drive to Aix-en-Provence where you will visit the Cathedral of the Holy Saviour. Sitting on the site of a former Roman forum and amalgamating a variety of architectural styles from the 5th- to the 17th-centuries the Cathedral boasts a richly decorated Gothic fa?ade with elaborately carved doors and to the north of the building an unfinished tower. You will then walk through the historical district to reach the lovely Mazarin guarter a residential area built for the town's gentry in the second half of the 17th-century. A chance to relax then follows on the 90-minute drive up to Avignon after which you'll have some time for lunch in one of the town's many brasseries before moving on to the monumental Papal Palace the seat of Christianity in the 14th-century and now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Rich in galleries and chapels as well as frescoes and hand-painted wall-hangings in the private papal suite the palace still bears testament to its former opulence. The pleasant return drive to Marseille and your ship then brings the tour to an unhurried close. Please note: this tour includes long periods of walking on uneven ground with stairs to negotiate; it is not available to guests who use a wheelchair. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. 








Camargue region in the south of France. The city was once the main Roman colony of ancient Gallia Narbonensis. UNESCO listed the city's Roman and Romanesque monuments as World Heritage Sites in 1981. The Dutch post-impressionist painter, Vincent van Gogh, lived in Arles for a year between 1888 and 1889, during which time he produced more than 300 paintings and drawings. Your panoramic walking tour includes the main sights such as the Church of St. Trophime, which once held cathedral status, the "Place du Forum" that inspired van Gogh's famous painting and the Roman amphitheatre, whose 120 arches date back to the 1st-century. The amphitheatre was capable of seating more than 20.000 spectators and was built for providing entertainment for the masses in the form of chariot races and gladiators engaged in bloody hand-to-hand combat. You will have time to explore on your own before returning to the ship.Please note: as the tour involves walking on uneven and rough ground, it is not suitable for guests using a wheelchair. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. 


Formerly a quiet fishing village on the southern coastline of France near Marseille Cassis has grown into a charming small town and popular international tourist resort.
