### HAF04 - JERUSALEM

#### CITY TOUR



Come with us on a 2-hour drive to Jerusalem, one of the most inspiring cities in the world and renowned for its historical significance, spiritual symbolism, and visual splendour. Your excursion will begin with a stop at Mount Scopus to enjoy the breathtaking view. The visit continues with a walking tour through the old town of Jerusalem. Pass Dung Gate, the Western Wall - the remains of the second temple destroyed by Romans in 70 AD and the most sacred Jewish shrine in Jerusalem. Walk along a part of the "Via Dolorosa", considered by Christians to be the holiest road in the world, the path where Jesus was led to death. You can also admire the Church of the Holy Sepulchre without entering the tomb. A stop to enjoy a lunch based on traditional food will be followed by a trip to a souvenir store in Jerusalem, from where we will drive back to Haifa port. Please note: Limited number of guides in languages other than English. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. As the tour involves walking about 2.5 km (1.5 miles) over uneven, cobbled terrain with some steps and inclines, guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for visits to places of religious importance; guests are further recommended to wear comfortable shoes. Popular locations may be crowded, and queues must be expected; we recommend staying with your guide all the time. Guests with any type of food intolerance are required to communicate it to the Shore Excursions Office at least two days before the call.

### HAF08 - BAHÁ'Í GARDENS, ANCIENT ACRE & THE KNIGHTS TEMPLAR

SCENIC ROUTE



Visit Mount Carmel and the ancient town of Acre. Your route takes you via Stella Maris Carmelite Monastery to Panorama Ave, named for its astonishing view of the city, Haifa Bay, the coastline, and all of northern Israel. Stop to view the Bahá'í Gardens, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, from the upper terrace. These are the largest hanging gardens in the world. The shrine is the second holiest place for the world's Bahá'í community. Continue your drive down Mt. Carmel, leaving Haifa and crossing the bay to Akko (Acre), the oldest city in the northern region. More than 4,000 years of recorded history will unfold before your eyes as you walk through Acre's narrow cobblestone passageways and colorful bazaar. The present-day town was built in the 18th century on the ruins of the 12th-century Crusader city. Acre has changed hands and names many times over the millennia, but since 1948, it has returned to its biblical name of Akko. Visit the Crusaders' Halls, built by the Hospital Knights (the Knights of St. John) and the subterranean Crusader city. Walk past Al Jazzar's Mosque, built in the 18th century, through the bazaar to the port and Khan el-Umdan (Inn of the Pillars), a handsome 18th-century caravanserai. Then descend to the 12th-century level again to visit the unforgettable Templars' Tunnel. This amazing engineering feat is a tunnel more than a thousand feet long, carved through solid stone, connecting the fortress (no longer standing) to the port (still intact). As its name implies, the Knights Templar constructed the tunnel, the Crusaders charged with guarding the temple in Jerusalem. The Saladins forced the Templars to retreat to Acre, which was their last bastion in Israel until the Fall of Acre in 1297. The tunnel will lead you to the lighthouse and the sea wall. You will have some free time to shop in the bazaar before returning to Haifa and the ship. Please note: Limited number of guides in languages other than English. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. This tour includes walking on uneven ground; guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Moreover, it is unsuitable for guests suffering from claustrophobia.

### HAF11 - BIBLICAL HISTORY TOUR: NAZARETH, CAPERNAUM & TABGHA

A place of miracles in ancient times and a popular spot with tourists and pilgrims today, this excursion covers another important sight of the Holy Land - the Sea of Galilee. This large water mass is not actually a "sea" but a lake: the largest freshwater lake in Israel and located near the Golan Heights. It was here that Jesus conducted most of his ministry activities and where many of Jesus' miracles happened, such as walking on water and the "Feeding of the 5000". We will drive to Nazareth, the largest city in the North District of Israel and the childhood home of Jesus, according to the New Testament. Many guests will be interested in paying a pilgrimage to the surprisingly modern "Basilica of the Annunciation", a church built on the site where the Gabriel announced the news of Jesus' birth to the Virgin Mary; visitors can see the underground grotto where Mary received the Annunciation. Next, we will reach Capernaum, the ancient city of Galilee; the town is mentioned in the New Testament in the Gospel of Luke and is reported to be the home of the Apostles Peter, Andrew, James, John, and Matthew. We will walk around the ruins of the synagogue where Jesus taught on the Sabbath and prayed. Proceed to Tabgha that is, according to tradition, the site of three of the most important episodes of the New Testament: the Sermon on the Mount, the miracle of the loaves and fishes and the appearance of Jesus after Resurrection. After lunch you will proceed to the Mount of Beatitudes, the hill from where Jesus gave his famous "Sermon on the Mount" and where Pope John Paul II celebrated a mass in March 2000. Please note: Limited number of guides in languages other than English. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. As the tour involves walking on uneven ground, guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for visits to places of religious importance. The coach transfer to the Sea of Galilee takes about 2 hours. Guests with any type of food intolerance are required to communicate it to the Shore Excursions Office at least two days before the call.

### HAF10 - JERUSALEM & BETHLEHEM

CITY TOUR



A trip to the Holy Land would hardly be complete if it failed to include visits to two of the most famous places in the world, the Israeli city of Jerusalem and the small Palestinian town of Bethlehem. This tour gives you a chance to do both and begins with an approx. 2.5-hour coach ride through fascinating landscape from Haifa to Jerusalem, one of the most inspiring places on earth and renowned for its historical significance, spiritual symbolism and visual splendour. Your tour of Jerusalem city begins with a stop at Haas Promenade, one of three connected public parks, for breathtaking views over the town. A walk through the old town of Jerusalem then follows, taking you through Jaffa Gate and along part of the "Via Dolorosa". Widely held to be the holiest of roads by Christians all over the world, this is the path that Jesus took on his way to the cross. The tour also includes a chance to see the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, but without entering the tomb. Then it is on to the Western Wall, an important site of Jewish worship that also forms part of the outer retaining wall of the adjacent Temple Mount. After some time to relax and enjoy a lunch based of traditional food, you will continue to Bethlehem and pay a visit to the Church of the Nativity, at the birthplace of Christ. Completed in 339 A.D., it is accepted as the oldest continuously operating Christian church in the world. Your tour of two holy cities ends with your return to the port of Haifa and your ship. Please note: Limited number of guides in languages other than English. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. As the tour involves walking about 2.5 km (1.5 miles) over uneven, cobbled terrain with some steps and inclines, guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for visits to places of religious importance; guests are further recommended to wear comfortable shoes. Popular locations may be crowded, and queues must be expected; we recommend staying with your guide all the time. The tour includes only an outside visit to the Silver Star grotto. Guests will need to be in possession of their passport to enter Bethlehem. As not all guides can enter Bethlehem, a local and English-speaking tourist escort may accompany you instead. Your guide will join your coach only after the visit to Bethlehem. Guests with any type of food intolerance are required to communicate it to the Shore Excursions Office at least two days before the call.

### HAF15 - THE DEAD SEA DE-STRESSING TOUR

Leave the port and enjoy a 3.5-hour coach drive to the Dead Sea. This de-stressing tour of the Dead Sea, which was formed more than two million years ago in a hollow 412 metres below sea level, will give you an opportunity to experience the deeply relaxing and therapeutic effect of floating in its high-saline waters. The Dead Sea is the lowest place on earth and the only place in the world where water is heavier than your body; water has 35% salt and mineral and that's make this place the best place in the world for skin problems. You may also like to experience the beneficial effects of a clay-mud bath - anecdotally alleged to revitalize the system due to its high concentrations of minerals such as silicates and carbonates. Your Dead Sea tour is rounded off by a buffet lunch of traditional food and time to go shopping. Please note: Limited number of guides in languages other than English. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. The salt concentration of the Dead Sea water can cause swimwear colors to fade. We recommend a maximum time of 20 minutes for bathing in the Dead Sea and for direct exposure to the sun. The tour is unsuitable for guests who suffer from low blood pressure or heart problems. Children aged less than 16 years old cannot bathe in the pools inside the resort. Once on the beach, you can rent an umbrella and a deckchair and, if you work up an appetite, buy a snack or a refreshing drink at the restaurant at the end of the beach. Awarded the Blue Flag, the beach is also suitable for families with children thanks to its shallow waters a few metres from the shore. At the appointed time, take the coach back to the port and the ship. Please note: this excursion is available from June to September and is subject to weather conditions. It is advisable to bring a beach towel and sunscreen.

**LIM06 - SCENIC CYPRUS, VILLAGES & MILLOMERI WATERFALLS BY JEEP**

**ACTIVE & ADVENTURE**



The beautiful Mediterranean island of Cyprus is known for its splendid beaches, an interesting and eventful history dating right back to the 10th millennium B.C., a whole host of archaeological remains as well as wonderfully varied scenery and unbroken summer sunshine. The itinerary of this entertaining tour first takes you to the largest man-made dam on the island; its construction caused a whole village - Alassa - to be relocated to a nearby side. Next destination is the village of Lofou, named after the hilly landscape which stretches around it like a large amphitheatre. Even though there is no information on the exact date of the founding of the village, it is assumed that the first inhabitants appeared during the Arab raids of the 7th century. The tour then continues by jeep again for a drive through the dense pine forest of the Troodos Mountains en route to one of the island's nature wonders, the beautiful Millomeri Waterfalls, which you will reach after a short walk. Do take your camera to take some photos of this special place to add to your album at home. Last on the itinerary is the village of Lania, one of the country's main wine producing villages. It seems that the name Lania derives from Lana, the daughter of the wine god Dionysus, and during the stop you will see the old wine press, the Commandaria Storage Museum, and an old olive press. A relaxing return drive to Limassol port and your ship then brings your tour to a perfect close. Please note: the tour is unsuitable for guests with neck/back problems and pregnant women. The driver will provide information in English only during the trip. On calls falling on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays, guests will not have the opportunity to see the production of local products.

### LIM09 - ARCHAEOLOGICAL DISCOVERY TOUR TO PAPHOS



CULTURE AND HISTORY

Paphos is an ancient town located on the southern coast of Cyprus, 1 hour far from Limassol. Our first stop will be the Paphos Archaeological Park to visit the house of Dionysus, a luxury building of the Roman periods with rooms placed around a courtyard and destroyed by an earthquake in the 4th century. The house is famous for its beautiful floor mosaics that date back to the 3rd-century depicting scenes of mythology and hunting. You will have free time to stroll around this picturesque Paphos harbour which is located next to the Archaeological Park. The itinerary continues with a visit to the Tombs of the Kings, a magnificent necropolis located near the sea. The royal name should not mislead you as it refers to the majesty of the funerary buildings, some of which date back to the 4th century BC. Once at the site, walk down the avenue to an atrium taking to the eight tombs, each with a different architectural style. Before returning to the port, a short photo stop at Aphrodite's Rock, birthplace of the Greek goddess of love, concludes your excursion. Please note: This excursion includes walking on uneven terrain which may be uncomfortable for guests with limited mobility.

### LIM11 - ICONIC CYPRUS: APOLLO'S TEMPLE, KOLOSSI CASTLE & VITICULTURE



CULTURE AND HISTORY

This excursion may well take in the sights of Apollo, but we will also be paying homage to the Greek god Bacchus as we learn also about island's history of wine! Our first stop is at the Temple of Apollo, the largest and most important religious centre on the island and which was in continuous use from the VIII century BC to the IV century AD. We will continue to the nearby village of Kolossi to visit the castle, left over from the time of the Crusaders in Cyprus. The XIII century Kolossi Castle is linked to the history of wine production on the island, in particular to the manufacture of the local Commandaria wine. Our tour includes a visit to the Cyprus wine museum to learn about the 7500-year tradition of winemaking in Cyprus. Naturally, we will have time to sample a glass of Cyprus wine before returning to the port.

### LIM10 - ANCIENT KOURION & PRETTY OMODOS



CULTURE AND HISTORY

A short drive by coach takes you to the remains of the ancient town of Kourion, which survived from antiquity until the early middle ages, and is considered the most important archaeological site on the island. Overlooking the bay of Episkopi, the site is a constant discovery thanks to ongoing excavations that bring to light new treasures. The guided tour will let you discover the fully restored Greco-Roman theatre and the House of Eustolio with its beautiful floor mosaics. You will learn that the House was originally a Roman villa and then was turned into a public recreation centre. The excursion continues to Omodos, a picturesque small town located inland at 800 metres above sea level, and well known for the wine that is produced in the surrounding area. You will visit a local winery for a delicious wine-tasting session including the Zivania, the Cypriot pomace brandy. Then, take a stroll in Omodos, explore its perfectly preserved historical centre and visit the Church of the Holy Cross. Tradition has it that a piece of the rope with which Jesus was tied to the cross is kept in the church. The tour ends with your return to the ship. Please note: guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for visits to places of religious importance.

### LIM12 - INDEPENDENT EXPLORATION: LARNACA & LEFKARA SILVER & EMBROIDERY

We will drive to Larnaka, the oldest living city in Cyprus and originally known as Kition, the birthplace of the Stoic philosopher Zeno. Linked to early Christian times, Larnaca is a special place for Christians as the town's bishop was St. Lazaros (Lazarus) who chose to spend his "second life" here after Jesus raised him from the dead. A church built in his name exists on the spot where his remains were said to be found. When we reach Larnaca, you will have free time to explore on your own. We will then return to Limassol via Lefkara, a village famous for its traditional style of lace embroidery, known as the "Lefkaritika". Also, here there will be given free time to explore the village by yourself, before returning to the port.

### MYK04 - DELOS: THE ISLAND OF GREEK MYTHOLOGY

CULTURE AND HISTORY



Situated in the middle of the Cyclades Group lies Delos, the "Island of Light", and the destination of this enjoyable tour. After a short boat trip, your exploration of Delos' historical remains and rich mythology can begin. Legend has it that Zeus took a shine to the beautiful Leto, in the course of which affair she fell pregnant. However, this drew the ire of Zeus' wife, Hera, who promptly forbade Mother Earth to give Leto refuge. Just when all hope seemed to be lost, a serendipitous island - Delos - rose out of the sea, giving Leto a safe haven to deliver twins Artemis and Apollo. Popular as a pilgrimage site among ancient Grecians, Delos became one of the wealthiest shrines of antiquity. Among the remains of this era is the Avenue of Lions, so named for a row of originally 7th-century Naxian-marble lions that seem to guard the spot where Leto is said to have given birth. You can then crown your exceptional experience by taking the path up to Mount Cynthos, from whose peak Zeus is said to have watched the birth of his twins. Do not let the uphill hike deter you, for the mind-blowing view from the peak is worth every step. Round out your visit by exploring some of the numerous other monuments at the site before beginning your return journey to your port. Please note: this tour includes approximately 1.5 hours of walking, at times over uneven surfaces. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part.

Venture out and uncover the many different facets of Mykonos island, the "St. Tropez of Greece". Just how much the island has to offer is yours to discover on this relaxing and mainly coach-based tour, which begins with a drive to the so-called Panorama vantage point. A photo stop will give you a chance to capture beguiling views of Mykonos town and the old port, before a scenic route will take you through the picturesque villages of Agios Ioannis and Kalafatis as well as past the cosmopolitan beach of Ornos. A generous helping of warm Greek hospitality then awaits you in a village taverna, giving you a chance to reflect on your day of Mykonian magic as you relax to the aniseed flavour of ouzo and the savoury goodness of typical Greek appetizers. More pleasing views can then be enjoyed during the return drive to the port and your ship. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is not only home to the archaeological remains of several ancient buildings, but also the location of the amazing Parthenon, the symbol of Athens. Built between 447 and 432 B.C., the Parthenon temple was originally dedicated to the Greek goddess Athena, was then converted to a Christian church in honour of the Virgin Mary in the 5th-century A.D. and was finally turned into a mosque, for which a minaret was added to the complex, in the 15th-century. Today, the Parthenon is widely seen to be an abiding symbol of ancient Greece and as the birthplace of modern democracy. To save your feet, the scenic tour will take you to see all the main attractions of this profoundly historic city from the comfort of a modern coach. You will have time to visit the amazing National Archaeological Museum - an archive of rare artefacts that knows no rival - and the meticulously restored old part of Athens, the so-called Plaka district. The beautiful old buildings in Neoclassical style, narrow lanes and archaeological remains that characterise the district give the place an old-world feel that is sure to capture your imagination. Exciting, exclusive, edifying: three attributes that not only aptly describe this tour, but also the Greek island of Santorini itself, which was created when the crater left by a huge volcanic eruption collapsed, leaving only the rim, a so-called caldera. After a short boat ride to Athinios port, you will continue by coach to explore the island's history, capital, and dramatic landscape. First up is ancient Akrotiri, a town that flourished during the Minoan Bronze Age, but then fell victim to a major volcanic outbreak that covered it ash in the middle of the 2nd millennium B.C. Since excavation work began in 1967, many extremely well-preserved artefacts have been uncovered, including frescoes and even some three-storey buildings. You will have about 1.15 hours to enjoy this prehistoric site before you move on to Fira, Santorini's capital, for more free time to spend as you please. The pretty lanes are fun to walk down, the cafés great for a pit-stop and the views of the Kamenis, twin volcanic islets in the bay, spectacular. Last up is Oia, a blue-and-white village in Cycladic style perched on the very edge of the caldera. After a guided walk through its pretty cobbled streets, a stop at a local winery will give you a chance to sample local delicacies made of cheese, tomatoes, olives, and bread accompanied by a delicious wine tasting session. The return to the port to pick up the tender boats and get back on board could be by coach to Athinios or by cable car from Fira.
