All other countries must pay USD 150,00 onboard to go ashore - possible to remain onboard without Visa</p> <p>SADC Countries (South Africa, Angola, Botswana, Cape Verde ; Swaziland, Lesotho, Malawi, Mauritius, Namibia, Kenya, Seychelles, Tanzania, Zambia, and Zimbabwe) are Visa exempted.</p> <p>Guests holding passports from the following nationalities will no longer be able to obtain a Mozambican visa onboard when visiting ports in Mozambique: Bangladesh, Ethiopia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Somalia.</p> <p>These guests are now required to apply for and obtain a valid Mozambican visa prior to their cruise.
